

# 61st Annual Exhibition 2024

### **Image Format**

#### **Prints**

- Prints must be mounted behind a firm neatly cut, plain black or white window matte and firmly attached. Framed prints will **not** be accepted.
- 2. The matte should be at least 220gsm weight.
- 3. Ensure that there is no loose tape or sticky residue which might damage other prints when stacked.
- Tape should be placed all the way around the back of the print or backing sheet and be able to withstand being handled/displayed multiple times.
- 5. Plastic sticky tape is **not** allowed.
- 6. Maximum size of finished print (ie. print plus the matte) is 41cm x 51cm (16" x 20") in either portrait or landscape orientation.
- 7. Minimum width of matte is 4cm and maximum is 10cm.
- 8. Combined thickness of the mount and print must **not** exceed 4mm.
- 9. Panoramas (prints) will be accepted for judging. Finished print (ie. print plus the matte) must not exceed 51cm.
- Prints not complying with the above requirements will <u>not</u> be accepted for judging.
- 11. On the back of every Print entry, please place a label in the *centre* of the print with the following information:
  - Entrant's name, address, phone number (mobile is preferred).
  - Club at which the entrant is a member.
  - Title (max. 28 characters, including spaces).
  - Category letter to correspond with the entry, eg. "A" or "B" etc.
  - · Year the image was captured
  - An arrow pointing to the top of the print and the word "TOP" to indicate the correct viewing position - the arrow is to be placed in the top right corner of the label.

Minimum size for the label is 10cm wide x 8cm high.

Please *do not* place the label at the extreme corners of the back of the print as this may be covered with the chosen method of attaching the image for display purposes.




Fig. 1 - Matte and Print




Fig. 2 - Example of Label



## Image Format cont.

### **Digital Images**

- 12. The maximum horizontal dimension is 1920 pixels and the maximum vertical dimension is 1200 pixels. Panoramas are permitted as long as they comply with these maximum dimensions.
- 13. Each image file should be:
  - · sRGB JPEG format, and
  - Maximum file size of 3MB at 300dpi
- 14. Images must be submitted in the correct orientation. Images that are incorrect orientation will **not** be judged.
- 15. Image filename is irrelevant however, the 'Title' must be entered correctly online max. 28 characters including spaces.



### **General**

- 16. As part of entry, digital images must be submitted for both 'Print' and 'Digital Image' media.
- 17. The title of an image should be exactly as required to appear in the catalogue.
- 18. Entrants are reminded to keep a copy of the "List of Images" at the completion of the on-line submission. A copy of the "List of Images" must accompany the delivery of the entrant's Print entries.

#### **Uploading Images**

19. **All** entries (print and digital images) must be entered online at sapf.myphotoclub.com.au
